- Data: Continue entering monthly monitoring data. IPSC team will conduct individual outreach to determine what assistance you may require to accomplish monthly monitoring data entry into CDS for months October 2015 through January 2016 by April 15.
- Operational Metrics: PFE/Leadership & Governance/Disparities and Cultural Competency updates that are due into CDS are the same questions as Needs Assessment. While IHA uploaded any changes for the initial reporting period, CDS will not reflect as submitted but instead lists "no data." HRET has validated they have received so absolutely NO need to worry of any delinquency. For the next reporting period, you will need to enter.  
2/1/16-4/30/16 Due into CDS May 31  
5/1/16-7/31/16 Due into CDS August 15

Enter details; date, min. FiO2, min. Peep and simply click "Calculate VAC" and it will indicate whether your case meets the VAE criteria

- **How do we know when our NHSN data pulls over within the CDS?**  
HRET last pulled NHSN data into the CDS on March 29. The next NHSN data pulls are scheduled for April 15 and April 28.
- **If my SIR rate is low, will it show up in CDS?**  
HRET is looking in to why some hospital SIR rates are not populating in CDS from NHSN. Remember that for the HEN 2.0 project, a SIR or Rate is acceptable for those NHSN-reported measures.
- **Will the project continue and will it satisfy as a PSO?**  
Information and guidance will be made available as it becomes known
